DTAS Assessor Course



The transport of raw milk and milk fractions is the essential link between the farmer and the milk processor. The DTAS Standards applied throughout this part of the dairy supply chain are vital to ensuring food safety, product integrity, maintaining quality and standing up to both internal and external scrutiny.

This course forms an integral part of the New Assessor approval process. The full protocols for new assessor approval are available in the DTAS Operating Protocols (Annex 2 – DTAS Assessor Criteria). Anybody considering applying to become a DTAS Assessor, is strongly advised to study Annex 2 – DTAS Assessor Criteria, before applying to participate in this DTAS Assessor Course.
