

DTAS Related Training What's Available?

If the milk transport sector and wider dairy industry is to be expected to embrace, comply with and be correctly and consistently assessed against the DTAS Standards, appropriate training is a necessary pre-requisite. There are now a number of different training courses available to meet the needs of different roles within the dairy industry and bulk milk transport sector. The following courses provide the necessary and appropriate training depending upon the individual's role.

DTAS Assessor and Internal Auditor Course

Course overview

- Two-day course
- Covers all DTAS Standards
- Based at a milk haulage depot
- Includes practical elements
- Focus on the correct interpretation of the DTAS Standards and compliant assessment
- Practice assessment
- Examination under exam conditions

Who's it for?

- **New DTAS Assessors** (See DTAS Operating Protocol – Annex 2)
- **Haulier Internal Assessors**

Frequency and Location

DTAS is obliged to run at least one of these courses annually, but more can be arranged on a demand led basis. The location will tend to reflect the location of those participating, wherever possible.

DTAS Assessor CPD

Course overview

- DTAS are required to provide an annual CPD for all **DTAS Assessors**
- Format and content tends to be informed via consultation and suggestions
- One day course

Who's it for?

- Approved DTAS Assessors only
- All assessors must participate in such a CPD event annually (or biannually if only doing one DTAS Visit annually)

Frequency and Location

Normally courses are arranged in the north and the south (Great Britain) to accommodate the location of existing DTAS Assessors.

- Opportunities to discuss practicalities and share good practice

- Other businesses who would benefit from a good understanding of DTAS
- Managers
- Supervisors
- New personnel
- Other personnel who would benefit from a good understanding of DTAS
- Haulier Internal Assessors (introductory)

Frequency and Location

Several courses are run annually on a demand led basis. In order to make them more accessible, these courses tend to be run at venues in the north, south and midlands (Great Britain) and in Northern Ireland.
