


MEMBERSHIP FEES 2024-2025 (2)






NUMBER OF SITES AUDITED PER MODULE (87 COMPLETED AUDITS)






NUMBER OF MODULES PER AUDIT (87 COMPLETED AUDITS)






NUMBER OF NON-CONFORMANCES PER DEPOT 2022/23

- Invoices for April 2024 March 2025 year will be issued following the Conference.
- Based on information held by Dairy UK.
- Please provide full details of any changes in number of depots, subdepots etc. to Dairy UK.
- Reminder is sent to each depot six weeks in advance of expiry of current certificate.
- Depot to notify Dairy UK when audit is scheduled.
- Failure to rectify non-compliances in time will result in depot no longer being deemed to be certified under the scheme and full assessment, at haulier's expense, required for re-certification.
- Failure to pay annual membership fee within 3 months of invoice will result in temporary suspension from scheme.
