



DTAS Awareness Course

Milk Hauliers, Milk Purchasers and Independents

The transport of raw milk and milk fractions is the essential link between the farmer and the milk processor, furthermore it is a requirement that all bulk raw milk and milk fraction transport for Red Tractor Assurance 'First Purchasers' needs to be provided by DTAS accredited hauliers only. The DTAS Standards applied throughout this part of the dairy supply chain are vital to ensuring food safety, product integrity, maintaining quality and standing up to both internal and external scrutiny.

The objective of this course is to provide milk transport managers, supervisors and anybody else involved in milk transport, with an understanding of how the DTAS Standards apply to their business. This course also meets the requirements of DTAS Standard A1.4 which requires self audits to be undertaken by a 'competent person'.

This optional course has been officially recognised by the DTAS Management Committee.
